



Co-funded by the European Program Erasmus+, the Cerasmus+ relies on three pillars:

Heritage Innovation Network



The Cerasmus+ project aims to protect the EU traditional heritage and to modernize the ceramic sector through 3 main objectives:

- 1 Creating a European network of ceramics stakeholders
- Combining ceramics tradition with innovative design and production techniques
- Revising and innovating vocational education in the ceramics sector through work based learning models.



The Cerasmus+ project implements as first step a field analysis to explore the needs for competences, for assuring the sector development through networking, protection of immaterial heritage and innovation.

The second step is the design and implementation of an on-line virtual environment addressed to ceramics key actors and stakeholders to discuss the main issues emerged from the ssessment stage and to open a permanent forum and assuring closer cooperation.

Finally, the project foresees the planning and testing of specific curricula for initial and continuous vocational training, focused in work based learning and aimed at gaining transversal and professional competences for the improvement of sector "value chain".
